Procedure for Disclosure of Evidence Audit Records

This Order establishes the procedure for the disclosure of evidence audit records in a juvenile proceeding, incorporating by reference Administrative Order No 20/24, issued by Presiding Judge Kirk H. Nakamura on October 15, 2020. (Attachment A.)

The Juvenile Court further incorporates by reference the Stipulation and Order Regarding Disclosure of Evidence Audit Records, Remedy Record Printouts and Associated Reports, attached to Administrative Order No. 20/24 and entered into by the Orange County Sheriff's Department, by and through its attorneys, the Orange County Counsel's Office, the Orange County District Attorney, and the Orange County Public Defender regarding disclosure of documents pertaining to the Orange County Sheriff's Department "Evidence Audit" records, Remedy system printouts, and Orange County Sheriff's Department reports ("DRs") associated with entries in the Evidence Audit Records ("the Stipulation" or "the Global Stipulation"), subject to the conditions and modifications noted in this Order. The process described in the Stipulation is equally available to other defense counsel upon agreement to be bound by the terms of the applicable protective order as set forth by the Stipulation.

For purposes of this Order: (1) Any reference in Administrative Order No. 20/24 or the Global Stipulation to "criminal proceedings" shall be understood to mean juvenile court proceedings; and (2) Any reference in Administrative Order No. 20/24 or the Global Stipulation

to "defendant" shall be understood to mean a juvenile justice involved youth. A copy of the Stipulation and Administrative Order No. 20/24 is attached to this Order as Attachment A.

Any evidence audit records disclosed in relation to a juvenile proceeding may contain confidential information subject to the protections of Welfare and Institution Code section 827. If there is information found within the records that is protected confidential information, the attorney of record for the youth shall not share or disseminate the protected information except to entitled parties as enumerated under Welfare and Institutions Code section 827.

This Order does not prevent any party from seeking records otherwise permitted by law.

This Order may be considered a "standing order" and is applicable to all juvenile proceedings in the Orange County Superior Court. This Order is effective immediately and shall remain in effect until modified by further Order of the Court.
