**ORDER PERMITTING CONSERVATOR TO LIQUIDATE ESTATE
OF DECEASED CONSERVATEE
(Probate Code Section 2631)**

UPON CONSIDERING the verified petition of the conservator _____
*(insert name of conservator)*for an order permitting the conservator to liquidate the estate of the deceased conservatee,

THE COURT FINDS that the total market value of the estate of the deceased conservatee does not exceed the amount determined under Probate Code Section 13100; that good cause exists for the petition to be granted as prayed; and that no notice of this petition need be given.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the conservator is authorized to sell the personal property of the deceased conservatee, to withdraw any money of the deceased conservatee in an account in any financial institution, and to collect any debt, claim, or insurance proceeds that may be owing to the deceased conservatee or the deceased conservatee's estate.
