NOTICE OF COURT REPORTER AVAILABILITY IN CIVIL COURTROOMS

Santa Ana, CA – Effective May 15, 2017, the Orange County Superior Court will no longer provide the services of an official court reporter in the following Civil departments: C10, C14, C15, C19, C20, C26, C31 and CX101. The Court is taking this step to address significant court reporter shortages despite continuous recruitment and hiring efforts dating back to December 10, 2015.

The list will be updated when judicial assignments, calendars, and/or services change.
