NOTICE OF FEE CHANGES

Effective October 19, 2010

As a result of the enactment of Senate Bill 857 (Stats. 2010, ch. 720), various civil, family law, and probate filing fees as well as criminal fees have been established or increased as of October 19, 2010. All new and increased fees sunset on July 1, 2013, except as noted below. The additional revenue from these fee changes will be used to offset reductions to trial court funding.

New fee

- \$500 renewal fee for application to appear as counsel pro hac vice for each year a case continues.

Increased Fees

- \$40 increase to first paper filing fees for unlimited and limited civil cases where the amount in controversy is more than \$10,000.
- \$20 increase to first paper filing fees for limited civil cases where the amount in controversy is \$10,000 or less.
- \$300 increase to the summary judgment motion fee.
- \$250 increase to the pro hac vice fee.
- \$10 increase to the security fee (sunsets on July 1, 2011).
