NOTICE

EX-PARTE APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY CONSERVATORSHIP

Effective 7/1/07, all Exparte Applications for Temporary Conservatorship will be set for one week after the date of submission to allow for a Court Investigation. A five (5) day notice will be required (Probate Code §2250).

Appearance of Conservatee is required at hearings for Temporary Conservatorships, with limited exception (Probate Code §2250.4).

If you are seeking to shorten or waive the five (5) day notice requirement, you must file a separate declaration detailing the immediate and substantial harm to the proposed person and/or estate that could occur during the notice period. If granted, the Court may grant the temporary only for the time to give notice and will require you to return after the required notice is given.
