**20% of Prospective Members Eligible to  
Serve on the Orange County Grand Jury are Minorities**

Santa Ana - A random drawing will be held Wednesday, May 16, 2001 to select the 19 finalist and 11 alternates to serve on the Orange County Grand Jury. The drawing will be held at 12:00 p.m. in Dept. C1 of the Central Justice Center, 700 Civic Center Drive West, Santa Ana.

"The composition of the prospective jurors includes 24 Caucasians, four Hispanics, one Asian and one African-American," said Judge Frederick P. Horn, Chair of the Grand Jury Recruitment/Selection Committee. "Women comprise 30% of the prospective grand jurors," added Judge Horn.

Canvassing efforts for prospective grand juror members included 2,150 applications that were mailed to prospective applicants, and flyers that were distributed to 943 companies and 140 minority organizations. Also, members of the Grand Jury Recruitment/Selection Committee spoke to organizations and appeared on Spanish and Vietnamese language television and radio programs to inform the community of the opportunity to serve on the Grand Jury.

The Grand Jury serves for a one-year term which begins July 1, 2001. The names of the grand juror nominees and the Supervisorial Districts in which they reside are as listed on the following page.
