**Carlos N. Olvera is Selected as Orange County's
2002-2003 Grand Jury Foreperson**

Santa Ana - Carlos N. Olvera, an engineering consultant and lecturer, who retired from Southern California Edison and from the United States Naval Reserve at the rank of Commander, has been selected as the Foreperson for the 2002/2003 Grand Jury which will commence on July 1, 2002 announced Assistant Presiding Judge David T. McEachen.

“Mr. Olvera has outstanding qualifications to serve as the Grand Jury Foreperson. He has extensive experience in writing analytical reports and has served on various community boards and organizations,” said Judge McEachen.

Olvera has been an Orange County resident for 18 years. He received his Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from Brigham Young University. He served as vice president and project manager for the construction of the Berlin Geothermal Power Plant in El Salvador and has managed operations at nuclear power plants.

Prior to their impanelment, the incoming 19 Grand Jury Members and first three alternates will participate in a six-day orientation and training program conducted by members of the present Grand Jury and advisors from the offices of the District Attorney and County Counsel. The 2002/2003 Grand Jury will be impaneled at a proceeding to be held in Department C1 of the Orange County Superior Court at the Central Justice Center in Santa Ana, on July 1 at 10:00 a.m.
