**CHRISTOPHER EVANS APPOINTED
ORANGE COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT COMMISSIONER**

Santa Ana - The judges of the Orange County Superior Court have appointed Christopher J. Evans, Esq., to the position of Superior Court Commissioner, announced Chief Executive Officer of the Court Alan Slater.
