**Requests for Extensions for Traffic Citations Now Available
At the Court's Website**

Santa Ana -The public can now request a first time 45-day extension for traffic citations at the Orange County Superior Court website www.occourts.org/traffic.

“This is a classic win-win project,” said Presiding Judge Frederick P. Horn. “Both the public and the Court save time and money. The public benefits because they can conveniently make the request from any computer with an Internet connection. Also, it’s a more efficient system for the Court that saves staffing resources.”

The following criteria are required to request an extension for one 45-day extension from the original due date:

- C No prior Extensions on the case.
- C No previous appearance in court for the case.
- C No Failures to Appear on Civil Assessments on the case.
- C You are not currently enrolled for Traffic School on the case.
- C The case does not require a Mandatory Appearance.

A request for extension does not guarantee that an extension will be granted. The public should allow 24 to 48 hours for the court to process the request. When the request is processed, a confirmation will be sent to the email address. If no email address is provided, the individual, making the request, will be contacted by telephone.
