Superior Court Facility Open in Mission Viejo for Payments and Self-Help Services

Mission Viejo, CA – Orange County Superior Court now accepts payments for criminal, traffic, and collection cases at its Mission Viejo facility. Payments can be made at the public windows only on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Appointments are not necessary and walk-ins are welcome. Drop box payments and mail are not accepted at this facility.



The Superior Court Service Center, pictured above, is located at 27573 Puerto Real, Mission Viejo, in a commercial shopping center accessible from the Crown Valley Parkway exit off the 5 Freeway. The Court opened this facility to provide access to court services to the more than 600,000 residents who live in south Orange County.

The Superior Court Service Center continues to offer assistance to self-represented litigants in various case types. Self-Help services include providing legal information and procedural assistance, offering workshops, providing document review of Judicial Council of California forms and Orange County approved local forms, public computer use, and legal library use.
