Roy Baker is Selected Foreperson of the Incoming Orange County Grand Jury

Santa Ana – Roy Baker has been selected as the foreperson for the 2011/2012 Grand Jury which begins a one-year term July 1, 2011, announced Presiding Judge Thomas J. Borris, Chair of the Grand Jury Recruitment/Selection Committee.

"Mr. Baker's many years of work experience as an officer in the United States Air Force, city/county government, and public schools will serve him well as Grand Jury foreperson," said Judge Borris. He added, "He has the desired management and communication skills necessary to lead the Grand Jury."

Mr. Baker graduated from Boston University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics and from Gonzaga University with a Master of Science degree in Human Resources Management. After retiring from military service, Mr. Baker worked for the city/county of Honolulu, Hawaii, as a purchasing administrator and for the Saddleback Valley Unified School District as a purchasing manager.

The 19 incoming Grand Jury members participate in a four-day orientation and training program conducted by members of the present Grand Jury and their advisors from the offices of the Orange County District Attorney and County Counsel. The 2011/2012 Grand Jury will be impaneled at a proceeding held at the Superior Court of California, County of Orange, in Department C1 of the Central Justice Center, Santa Ana, on Friday, July 1, 2011, 10:00 a.m.
