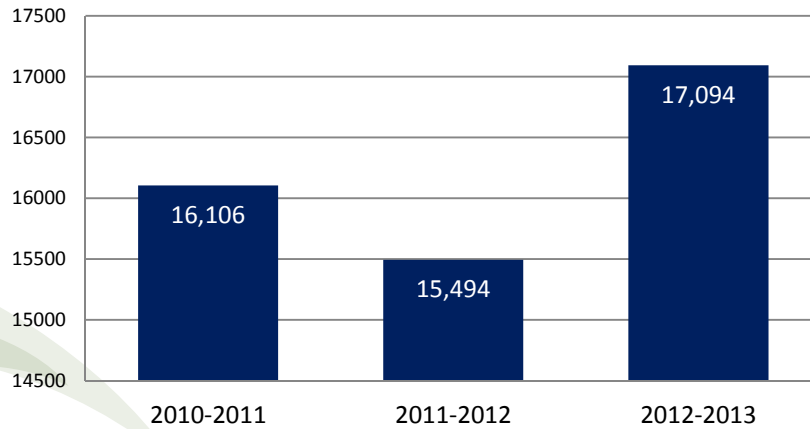

FELONY FILINGS

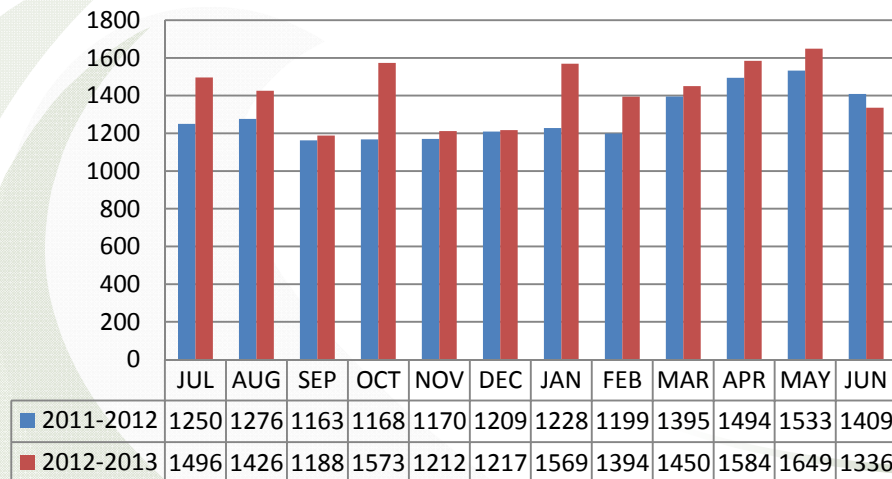


Annual Felony Filing Stats



- Felony filings have increased 6% since FY10-11.

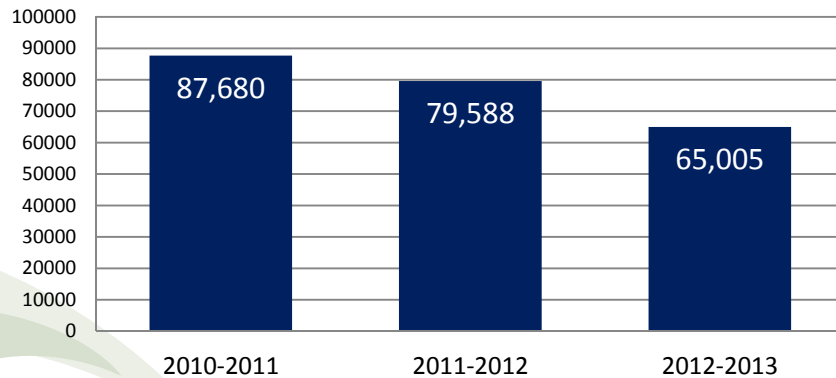
Monthly Felony Filings



MISDEMEANOR FILINGS

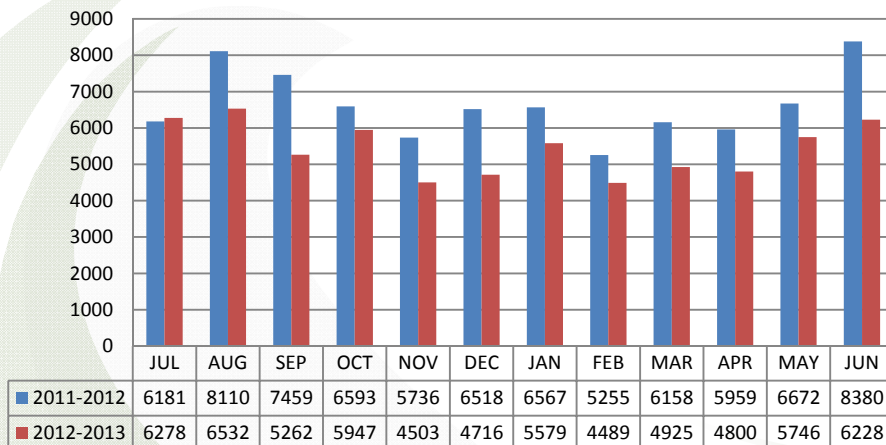


Annual Misdemeanor Filings



- While felonies have increased, misdemeanor complaints have decreased 26% since FY 10-11.

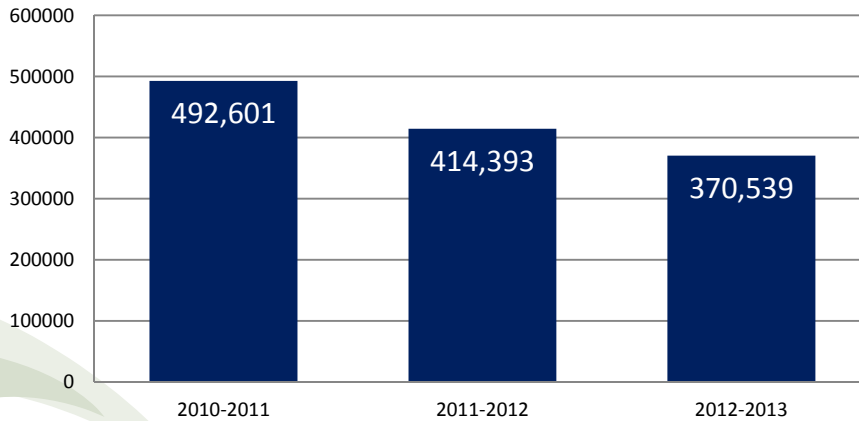
Monthly Misdemeanor Filings



INFRACTIONS

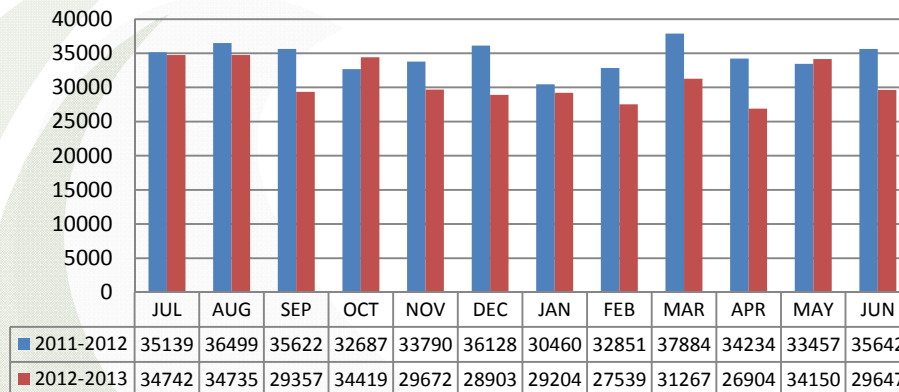


Annual Infraction Filings

Monthly Infraction Filings

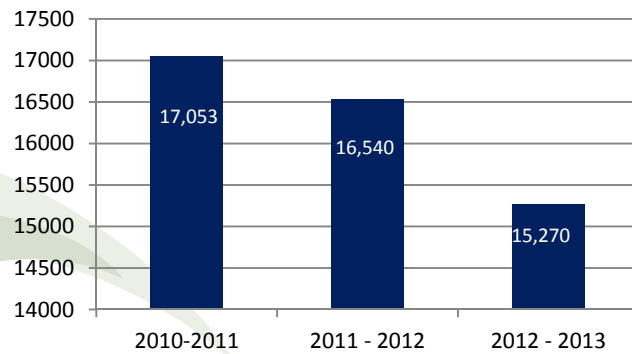


CIVIL FILINGS

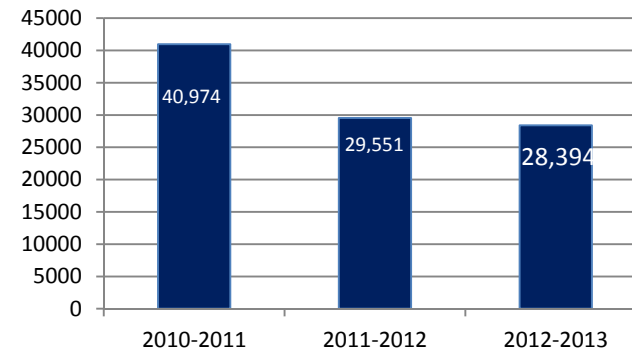


- Courtwide, civil cases have decreased 25% since FY10-11. Limited civil cases have seen the greatest decline, 30%, since 2010.

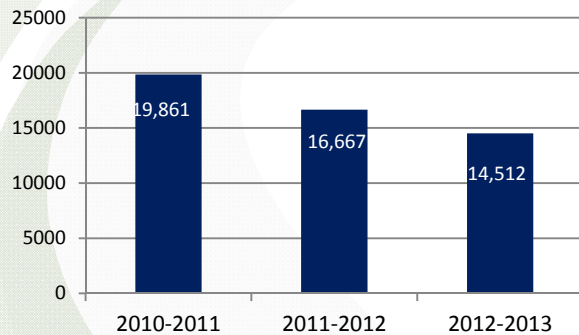

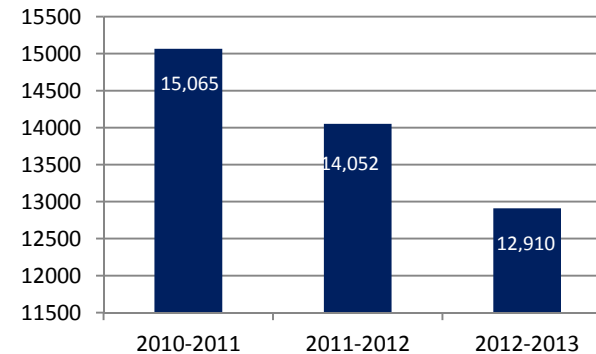

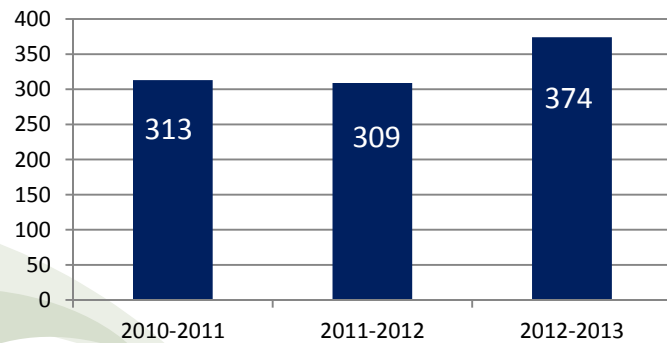

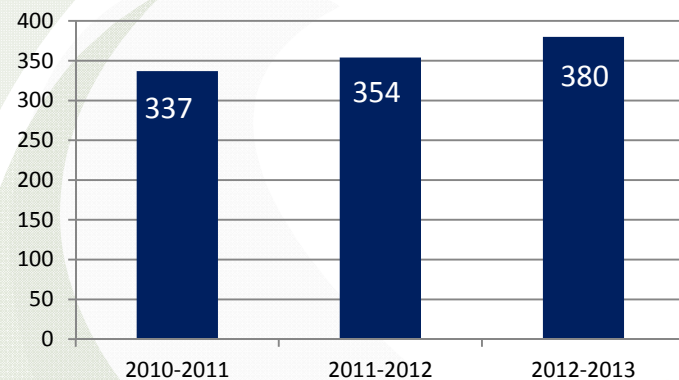


Probate Conservatorship



- Despite a general decrease in courtwide filings, increases have been occurring in Conservatorship and Guardianship filings since FY10-11, up 19% and 13%, respectively.

Probate Guardianship

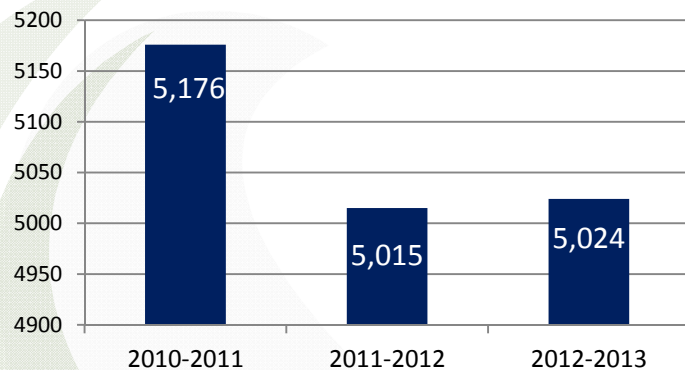


FAMILY LAW

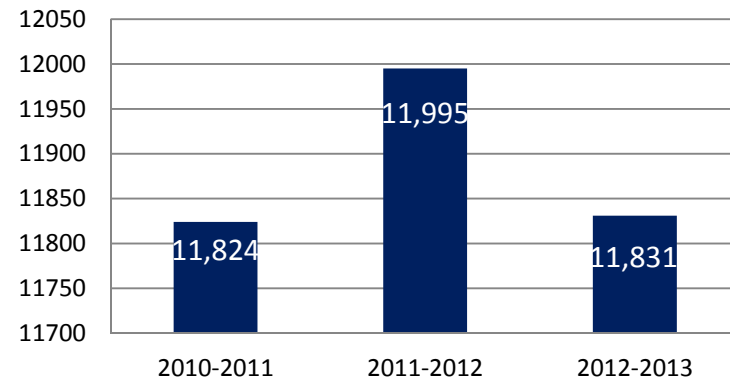


- Family Law filings have remained relatively stable compared to the general courtwide trend. The number of new Dissolutions cases filed in FY12-13 was equal to the number in FY10-11. However there was a 3% decline in Domestic Violence and Child Support filings compared to FY10-11.

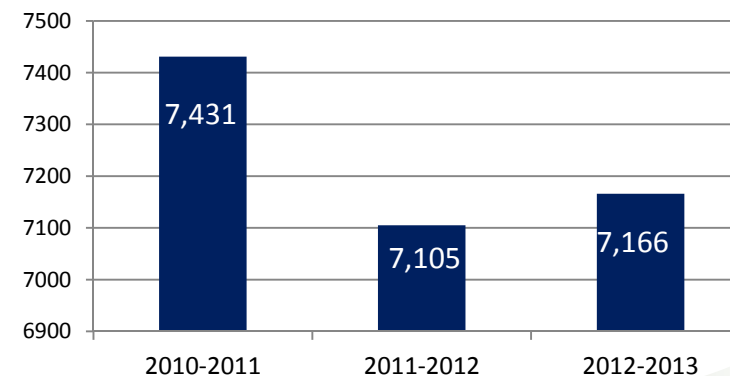
Family Law Domestic Violence



Marital Dissolution



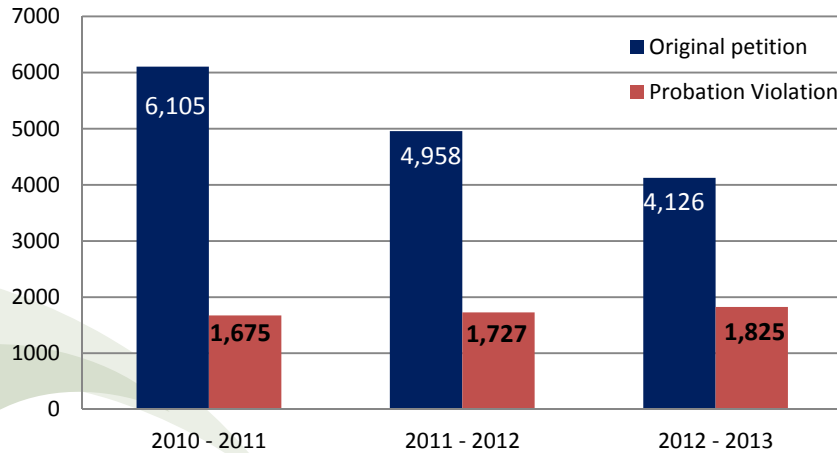

Juvenile Delinquency



- Filings in the Juvenile Court have decreased 24% from FY10-11. While initial Delinquency petitions have decreased more than 30%, supplemental filings have actually increased 9%.
- Dependency filings have also decreased 20% from the FY10-11 levels .
