


Zoom Remote Mobile Application Check-in September 5, 2024

This upgraded application replaces our previous version and offers enhanced features designed to improve user experience and accessibility, creating a seamless and efficient experience for all users.

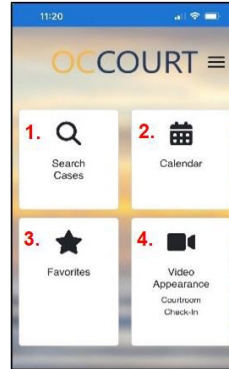

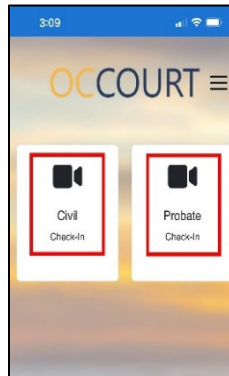
The mobile application can be added to your mobile devices home screen by clicking on the share icon  at the bottom of the browser. From the list, select Add to Home Screen, and select Add. The application can be launched anytime by tapping on the icon on your mobile device.

New Mobile Application

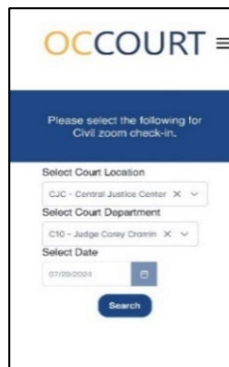


1. Search Cases – look up cases in selected departments
2. Calendar – to search for a case on a particular calendar
3. Favorites – a list of cases designated to favorites
4. Video Appearance - select button to check-in on a case on calendar

Check-in Process

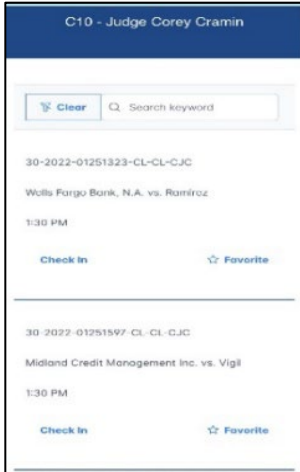


To check-in to a hearing, select Video Appearance, then select the appropriate case type.

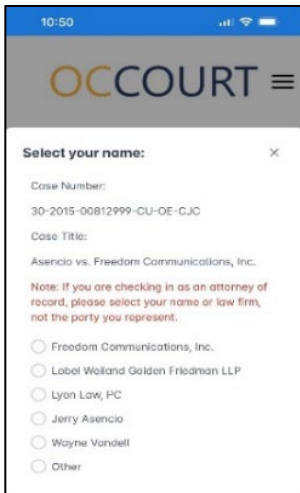


The user will then select the *Court Location*, and the *Court Department*. The current date will automatically populate. Then click search.

The calendar will display with all cases on calendar. Click *Check-In* for the case you are appearing on.



Check in as a party, attorney, or other and click *Check-in*.



Click "Join Meeting" to automatically sign in to Zoom. When the Court is ready, the host will let you into the hearing.
