- 3. Surrogacy Filings
- 4. Special Immigrant Juvenile Findings that include a FL-935 Application and Order for Appointment of Guardian Ad Litem (GAL)

COURTROOM

- 1. Judgments
- 2. Hearing Documents Over 25MB in Size that Cannot Be Compressed
- 3. Objections & Oppositions to Statement of Decision
- 4. Proposed Statement of Decision
- 5. Request for Statement of Decision
- 6. Subpoenaed Documents
- 7. Trial Exhibits
