1. Appearance Procedure

2. Notice in Probate Cases

Until further notice, parties must include the following language when serving notice of hearing and publication in all Probate cases:

3. Electronic Submission of Letters and Bonds

- > Until further notice, electronic submission of Letters will be allowed and require a signature (electronic, digital, or otherwise). Letters without signatures will not be accepted for processing.
- Until further notice, electronic submission of bonds will be allowed. The submitting partymust retain possession of the original bond and make it available to the court upon request
