



Self-Help Judgment Lab

The Judgment Lab assists self-represented litigants to use a self-guided computer program to complete many of the required forms to finalize a family law case. Self-Help staff will be available to provide guidance and direction. The Lab is only *conducted in English*.


Qualifying for the Judgment Lab

- ✓ Participants must be self-represented and have a divorce/legal separation or parentage case that is ready to be finalized.
- ✓ Participation requires basic computer and typing skills.
- ✓ Please contact Self-Help for ADA accommodations.
- ⊗ **Children are not permitted.** Children's chambers may be available for children ages 2.5 to 16 who are fully potty-trained and able to use the restroom on their own.

How do I know my case is ready to be finalized?

- Divorce/Legal Separation:** Default or Default with Agreement or Response Filed and Parties with an Agreement.
- Parentage:** Default or Default with Agreement or Response Filed and Parties with an Agreement.
- Is your case ready?** You may contact Self-Help to confirm your case is ready for the Judgment Lab.
