WE HELP:

Complete and file the court paperwork necessary to finalize your adoption. For example, if you are interested in adopting a child from the foster care system, we can help prepare the paperwork for your dependency adoption case and prepare you for your hearing.

Complete and file the court paperwork necessary to request De Facto Parent

Status. For example, if you are someone who cared for or has been caring for a foster child and are interested in applying for De Facto Parent Status so you can have a more active role in the case (provide evidence, participate in placement decisions, and access court records), we can provide document preparation assistance to do so.

When e-mailing or leaving a voicemail, please provide the following:

- Your full name; your social worker's name; the name and DOB of the child you are adopting;
- Your phone number;
- The best time between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday Friday for PLC to call you back. (Note that for non-emergency matters, it may take up to 5 business days for PLC to contact you.)
