NOTICE OF REDUCTION OF NIGHT COURT HOURS

Pursuant to Government Code Section 68106, the Superior Court of California, County of Orange is providing a 60 day notice of the reduction in the number of hours offered for traffic night court at each Justice Center.

Currently, each justice center offers traffic night court on the first and third Tuesday of each month. Effective July 3, 2012, each justice center will hold night court on one night per month, rather than two nights per month. To enhance accessibility to the court, the public will now have the option to schedule an appointment to attend traffic night court at **any** location listed below:

First Tuesday of the Month

Harbor Justice Center – Newport Beach
North Justice Center – Fullerton
West Justice Center – Westminster

Third Tuesday of the Month

Harbor Justice Center – Laguna Hills
Central Justice Center – Santa Ana

Reservations to appear in court must be made online at www.occourts.org or by calling 877-872-2122 to schedule an appointment.

As part of the Judicial Branch of government, the Superior Court receives its annual budget allocation through the Judicial Council of California. Due to continuing budget reductions, the Court continually looks for ways to reduce expenditures without compromising service to the public. The reduction of night court hours will achieve cost savings in court personnel, security and other associated costs, with minimal impact to the public.
